Pronunciator (Fort Lee library card required) is an interactive language-learning tool. You may choose from 60 languages. There are 3,000 language courses and 3 million lessons. Pronunciator features interactive conversations, scored quizzes, progress reports, virtual coaching, and pronunciation analysis (microphone needed). Get started by clicking on the Pronunciator logo.



Duolingo is a free language-learning platform that includes a language-learning website and app along with a crowd-sourced text translation platform and a language proficiency assessment center. Duolingo is ad-free and offers all its language courses free of charge. The language-learning website and app offer over 50 different language courses across 23 languages; more than 30 additional courses are in development.



<u>Memrise</u> is an online learning tool with courses created by its community. Its courses are mainly used to teach languages, but are also used for other academic and nonacademic subjects.



QuizUp is a multi-player game in which one user competes against another during seven rounds of timed multiple-choice questions of various topics. There are over 1,200 total topics available to users to choose from and all the questions are voluntarily submitted by content contributors. Most topics are available in different languages.

sporcle

Sporcle is a trivia quiz website on which users have a set time limit to name all the items within a given subject, such as presidents of the USA or the countries in Europe. Anybody with a Sporcle account is able to create a quiz.
